No trophies will be mailed. Unclaimed trophies become the property of the host club.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

OFFERED AT SATURDAY AM & PM, and SUNDAY SHOWS

NOVICE CLASS – For boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS – For boys and girls at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

MASTER CLASS - This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

CERTIFICATE OF MERIT (CM)

Beginner Puppy

The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Points are awarded at each 4 to 6 Month Beginner Puppy show to the dogs winning Best of Breed (BOB), Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed (BOS), Group 1, or Best 4 to 6 Month Beginner Puppy in Show in accordance with the points structure below. The Certificate of Merit requires a total of 15 points. Certificate of Merit points may be earned in 4 to 6 Month Beginner Puppy and Open Show competitions as well as within the Miscellaneous class at regular Conformation shows.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Due to AKC COVID guidelines: **ALL GROOMING WILL BE DONE OUTDOORS at exhibitors' cars.** No grooming tables in the building or at ringside and no setups in the building. Please provide your own tent for car side grooming. Everyone will be required to wear a facemask (for those with a medical condition, the ADA requires that reasonable accommodations be provided to those who cannot wear a mask, such as wearing a face shield) while in the building and in the ring. Only dogs called for the next class will be allowed in the building. **Each exhibitor/handler must present a completed, signed and dated COVID release form (to be sent with the Confirmation notices) when picking up armband numbers.** Please clean up after yourself and your dog. Failure to do so can result in an Event Committee Hearing. Exhibitors should follow their doctor's advice on attending the shows if they are in a high risk group for COVID-19.

No public seating will be available and social distancing will be enforced. You may want to bring your own chair if you want to watch judging, but be mindful of social distancing. While you should bring your own face coverings, there will be a limited amount available to ensure compliance with Virginia guidelines. **ON SITE LUNCHEAS AVAILABLE ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY ONLY.**

Space for un-entered dogs will not be provided at this show under conditions specified in Chapter 15, Section 12 of the Dog Show Rules and Regulations.

Errors on Entry Forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published date.

All dogs present must be on a leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in an exercise pen. Place all trash in provided cans or plastic bags.

Prizes and trophies will be awarded in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prizes and trophies must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show giving club disclaims any liability for prizes and trophies. None will be mailed.

Entries close at 6:00pm, Wednesday, October 7, 2020, at the address of the Show Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted. Telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms are not acceptable. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Please make all checks payable to Blue Ridge Shetland Sheepdog Club (BRSSC). **Checks for entry fees must be drawn on US banks.** Clubs reserve the right to charge a processing fee for checks drawn on foreign funds.

A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and a Recording Fee of \$0.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking test. These Event and Recording Fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, these fees are to be collected on the first day entered (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 1).
